

## CALL FOR PAPERS 2026/1

**Deadline for paper proposals: 1 June 2025**

#### Studies

Theoretical articles - Doctrine (subjects freely chosen by the authors)

The Studies section of the *Revue de Droit comparé du Travail et de la Sécurité Sociale* 2026/1 will publish theoretical articles - Doctrine - on topics freely chosen by the authors.

#### Format of contributions

Contributions must be in French, English or Spanish and must not exceed **40,000 characters**, including footnotes and spaces.

#### Manuscripts must be accompanied by the following information:

- Title of the article
- An abstract of approximately 400 words in French and English, as well as keywords in each language (approx. 5) to identify the content of the article
- Name of the author's institution or organisation
- The author's research fields and bibliographic references (two publications of their choice)
- The author's postal and e-mail addresses

#### Schedule

- Deadline for manuscript proposals, accompanied by a **title**, a **400-word abstract** and a **proposed outline: 1 June 2025**

- Answer to authors: **30 June 2025**
- Deadline for completed article submission: **15 November 2025**

#### Assessment procedure

Texts submitted to the Revue are subject to a double-blind peer review process from independent experts. Proposals for articles are first evaluated by the Editorial Board, which assesses the manuscript's admissibility. If accepted, the manuscript is submitted to two external reviewers for assessment. When the reviewers provide feedback, recommendations for minor or major changes can be made to the author. **All requests for major modifications require a second round of peer review.**

Based on the assessment, the Editorial Board of the Revue determines whether to publish the submitted manuscripts.
